Staying Connected in the Online World

In 2021, River Arts Alliance (RAA) was awarded a Creative Support for Organizations Grant from the Minnesota State Arts Board. The purpose was to improve our online presence and offer opportunities for our members to learn how to better use the internet for showcasing and selling their work. The following activities and actions were used to accomplish these goals:

- Presentation of Workshops on Zoom, including Social Media for Business, Square Up 101: Creating an Online Store, Photographing Works of Art for the Web, and Intro to Video for Artists. (Visit website for workshop videos.)
- Providing Professional Photography Services to members.
- ** Conducting a Survey to assess the needs of our membership and the arts community in the Winona region and improve our ability to support area artists.
- Redesign of the RAA website, including rebranding and updated technology. (See homepage sample below.)
- ** Adapting projects for online presentation, such as our 2021 Member Exhibit and Showcase (pictured on cover) while COVID-19 restrictions were in place.

Projects

- ** RAA Member Exhibit & Showcase: Annually, members are able to publicly display their recent work in a group exhibit. Moving the exhibit online in 2021 allowed all of our members—not just visual artists—to participate for the first time.
- ** Family Art Day: Held the first Saturday in September in partnership with the City of Winona Parks & Rec department. This free event attracts 500+ participants each year. In 2020, RAA curated and assembled bags of art supplies that were distributed to children in Winona.
- Winona Art Walk: Held the weekend before Thanksgiving in studios and galleries around Winona. Adapted to an online format in 2020, it is now a hybrid event which expands the reach beyond the Winona area.
- ** HBC Fence Project: This permanent art installation was completed in 2019 and is located west of Levee Park in Winona.



History

River Arts Alliance has its roots in the Blue Heron Project Committee. In 2006, this ad hoc group of artists and art supporters initiated a public statue project. 15 seven-foot Blue Herons, painted by local artists, were displayed in Winona locations and auctioned off, raising \$45,000 for Winona Fine Arts Commission grants.

This project's success, coupled with community discussions, resulted in the River Arts Alliance's formation to support the burgeoning artistic potential of the Winona region. In December 2014, River Arts Alliance became a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, focusing on arts education and support for local arts and culture.

Fiscal Sponsorships

Subject to board approval and a small administrative fee, RAA serves as fiscal sponsor of members' projects that require a non-profit sponsor to receive grants or other funds. Current and recent projects include:

- Winona County Historical Society: RAA assists in curating exhibits hosted in the Slaggie Family Lobby Art Gallery in the History Center.
- Winona Arts Center: Serving as the group location for the Winona Art Walk, this newly accessible venue offers the potential for new ways to work together.
- ** Great River Writes: RAA coordinates literary events with the Winona Public Library, La Crosse Public Library, and La Crosse writers associations.
- ** City of Winona: Partners for Family Art Day, the HBC Fence Project, and arts advocacy in the community.
- * Visit Winona: Reaches beyond the Winona community to attract visitors to RAA events.
